

Trees were removed around the retention pond to reestablish the green belt area in compliance with the Declarations of Restrictions (section 14), the recommendation of the Washtenaw County Water Resources Commissioner, and State Law. The trees presented a significant risk to the integrity of the retention pond as foreseen by the original designers of the pond and the Commissioner. We were advised that the cost to repair the retention pond once damaged would be very expensive and would most likely require us to meet new more stringent requirements. Three tree service companies were contacted and asked for quotes. The board unanimously chose the lowest price bid (Burman's Tree Service) to complete this work. The retention pond area is now in compliance with the Declarations of Restrictions.
